Crescendo executives say that deploying digital dictation and speech recognition applications from the Citrix server provides higher security and more efficient system administration. Dictation files don't have to be stored on the local PC; instead, dictation files are securely streamed to the central application. Users can even access their Citrix-based dictation solution through the Internet, increasing their productivity and data security while on the move.

Citrix users now can record dictation seamlessly using modern dictation devices. Dictation files are streamed directly to the server, where they are converted to text by the speech recognition engine.

Depending on a user's preferred workflow, the recognized text is returned to the workstation in real time, allowing the author to edit and sign it off. Alternatively, the text can be accessed by a transcriptionist for editing and finalization.
